 **KEY BIBLE VERSE**

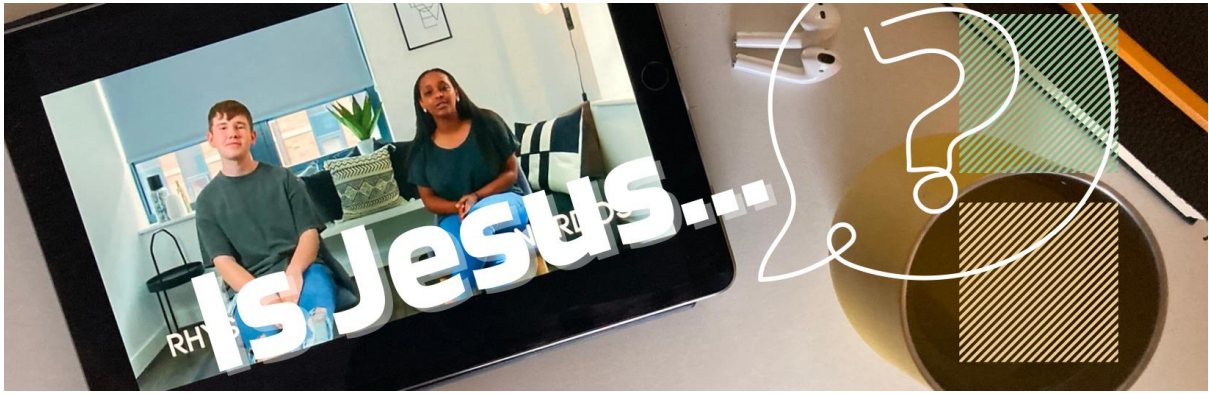

In this video session we explore how Jesus might still be relevant and what that means to young people today

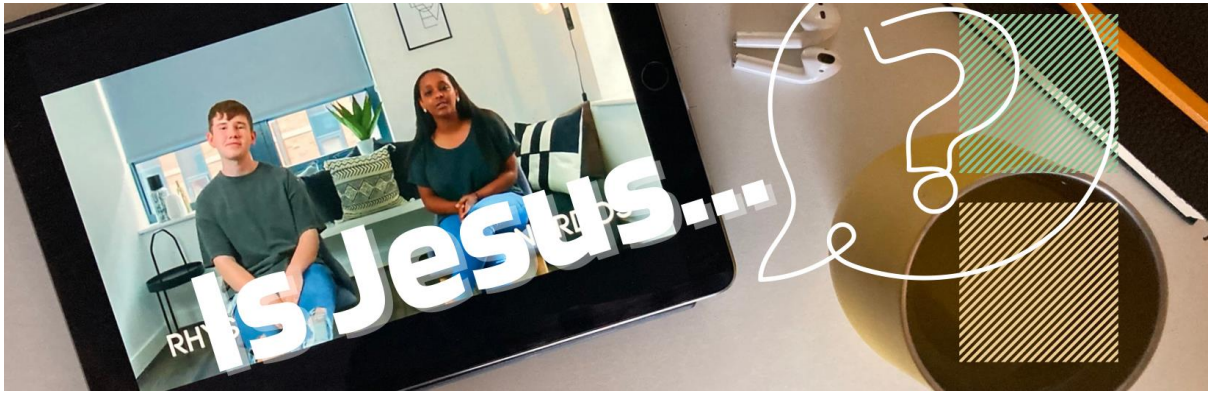
 **KEY BIBLE VERSE**

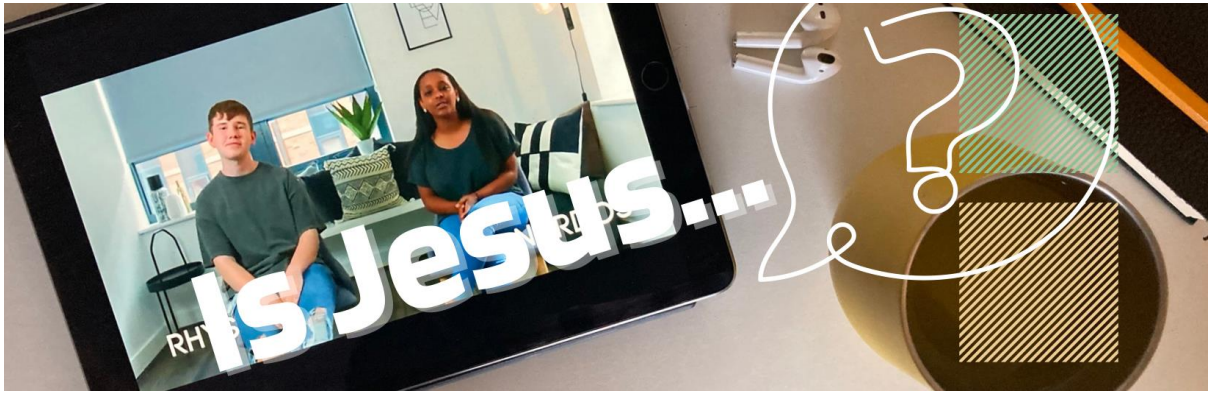
**SESSION 4 Learning Outcome**

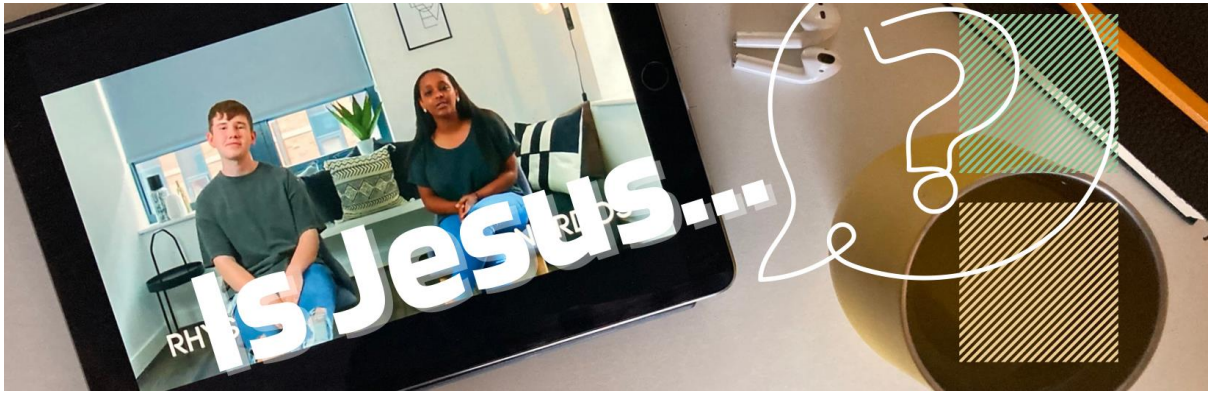
**SESSION 5 Learning Outcome**
